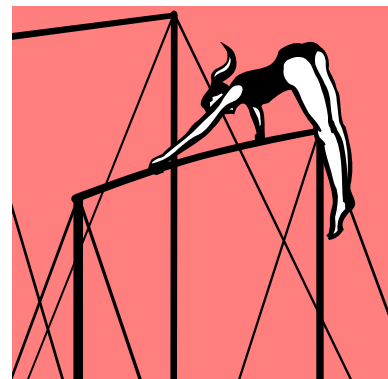

Procedures for Assigning Meets

The procedure for assigning compulsory only meets is the same, due to the ratings lasting for 8 years.

1. Assign requested judges with level of rating.
2. Assign judges who live closest to meet site.
3. Assign judges who can carpool together.

The procedure for assigning meets with optionals involved is as follows:

1. Assign judges with new ratings.
2. Assign judges who have tested but not passed new rating. These judges have studied the new materials and are still certified until December 31, 2009.
3. Assign judges that have not tested. (The procedure listed under the compulsory meets will be used with these guidelines.)

The assigning of all judges is done by their availability after the above requisitions are met. When Mary Ann goes into a meet to assign judges, she only sees the names of the judges that have marked that weekend available. **IT IS IMPERATIVE** you fill out your availability on the web site. If you have not marked your availability, Mary Ann will assume you are not available for meets when your name does not appear. Judges have been notified twice of the importance of checking their personal profile.
